IMPORTANT REMINDER - Tax Collection

Tax payments can be made in person at the **Brown County Treasurer's Office** located at 305 East Walnut Street, Room 160, Green Bay: Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. – 4:30 p.m. Payments can be made online at www.co.brown.wi.us or in person at the following financial institutions: All **Capitol Credit Union** (formerly Pioneer Credit Union) locations located in Brown County or at **Denmark State Bank** located at **103 E. Main Street**, Denmark, Wisconsin.

Please note: Dog license fees cannot be included in your tax payment. Please direct payments to Dawn Chervenka, Treasurer at 5856 Langes Corners Road, Denmark. An application can be requested from the Treasurer and/or is available online at the Town website under the Form section.

2015 Garbage/Recycling Schedule

Enclosed is the 2015 Garbage/Recycling Schedule from Advanced Disposal Services. Residents will see a charge of \$121.88 reflected on their tax bill in 2014 for garbage and recycling; this rate has not increased from last year. The yearly garbage fee is included on your tax bill whether you use the service or not. Larger size carts are available to residents for an additional monthly fee. Carts can be upgraded to a 65 gallon cart for \$2.00 a month or 95 gallons for \$3.00 a month. Advance will direct bill residents for this upgrade. Please contact Advance directly at 1-800-279-1930 or the Town Clerk if you are interested in an upgrade. 2015 Pickup schedules are also available online at the Town website.

Due to inclement weather, garbage pick-up may occasionally be delayed. Should this occur, please check the Town website (www.townofnewdenmark.com) or residents who receive electronic mailing from the Town will automatically receive notice of these last minute changes.

Dog Licenses: Dog Licenses must be purchased separately from the Treasurer and cannot be included in your tax payment. Pursuant to Wisconsin statutes, all dogs over 5 months of age must be licensed. Fees for SPAYED OR NEUTERED DOGS are **\$10.00** otherwise, the license will be **\$15.00**. You will need to furnish the dog's name, sex, breed, whether it is spayed or neutered and the date of last Rabies Vaccination when applying for a license.

Residents interested in running for a Town position are required to: circulate and file Nominations papers (GAB-169), a Declaration of Candidacy Form (GAB-162) and Campaign Registration Statement (GAB-1) with the Clerk, Michelle Wallerius prior to **January 6, 2015**.

The Town Board would like to remind residents an Informational Building Permit Form must be completed and returned to the Town Board for approval before the Building Inspector can issue a Building Permit. A Building Permit is required for any project that has a value of **\$500.00 or greater**. The Form can be obtained from the Zoning Administrator, the Town Clerk or online at www.townofnewdenmark.com. The Informational Building Permit Form must be submitted to Ralph Witte, Building / Zoning Administrator prior to the *regular monthly* meetings (which are held on the *second Monday* of the month) and will be reviewed collectively by the Town Board. Please include a diagram depicting the location of the proposed structure and please designate setbacks from the lot lines. Please keep this ordinance in mind if you are contemplating a building project and plan accordingly as these forms are only approved on a monthly basis.

Recycling Updates: Effective December 1st



The Tri-County (Brown, Outagamie and Winnebago Ctys) Single Stream Recycling Facility, in Appleton has expanded its processing capabilities to add new materials.

So what NEW items can you recycle?

- Cartons (milk, juice, soup, wine, etc.)
- Dairy containers (yogurt, sour cream, margarine, cottage cheese)
- Produce, bakery and deli containers (berry, donut, potato salad)
- Lids from above containers

The above list joins the materials you should already be recycling.

- Newspapers, inserts, magazines, junk mail and catalogs
- Cardboard and paperboard packaging (food boxes, soda boxes, etc. broken down)
- Office, writing and school paper and envelopes
- Phonebooks, other soft and hard cover books
- Paper bags, towel/toilet paper cores, paper egg cartons
- Shredded paper placed in a paper bag, stapled shut
- Glass food and beverage bottles and jars (all colors)
- Aluminum, steel, tin, bi-metal bottles and cans (including empty aerosol cans)
- Plastic beverage and household bottles and jugs

Whether a newly accepted material or one you've been recycling for years, always remember to empty and rinse your containers. Plastics bags in recycling containers can damage sorting equipment and cause significant maintenance issues. Recycle plastic bags at participating retail locations.



Recycling Christmas Lights

Do you remember when one burned-out light bulb rendered an entire string of Christmas lights virtually useless? Thankfully, that frustration has been remedied by light manufacturers, and burned-out bulbs are now easily identified and replaced. Yet, every year several million pounds of holiday lights are thrown into the landfills each. You should note, the value of worn-out lights and extension cords are gaining recognition. There is growing interest in recycling them, rather than throwing them in the landfill. If you would like to donate your lights, the Green Bay Habitat for Humanity ReStore collects old lights. 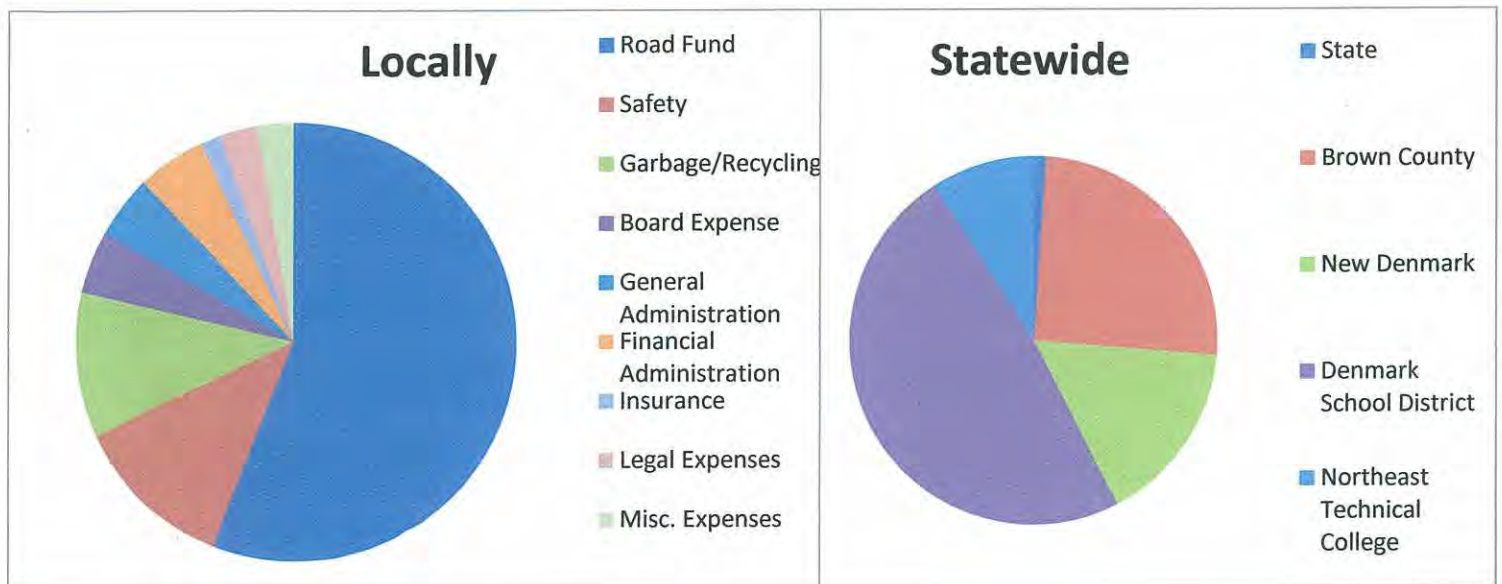

In addition, some local scrap metal businesses collect strings of lights and cords year-round, and may pay a small price per pound for them. Some hardware stores (such as Home Depot & Menards) offer recycling drop-off programs during the holidays. The Home Depot collects for two weeks in the early November (November 6th to November 16th). Menards collects November 1st to January 11th.

2014 Tax Roll

Residents will see a slight decrease in the *Town's* apportionment of the 2014 tax roll. The mill rate for 2014 will be 2.984 in comparison to 3.086 in 2013. Collectively, the mill rate for New Denmark increased slightly to 16.756, from 16.475 (2013).
